TITLE: Overnight Burglary Suspect Arrested

Ashwaubenon, WI – Late Sunday evening May 15, 2016 a burglary was reported at Taco Bell, 2530 Babcock Rd in the Village of Ashwaubenon.

Witnesses told police that an ex-employee, 19 year old Avery King entered the business through a back door, was able to get into the safe and fled on foot.

As officers were investigating the incident they located a potential suspect vehicle and verified that King was with that vehicle at the Motel 6 on Ramada Way in the Village of Ashwaubenon.

Ashwaubenon Officers along with assistance from the Brown County Sheriff's Office, De Pere Police and Oneida Police were able to locate King and take him into custody at the hotel at approximately 3am this morning.

King has been booked into the Brown County Jail with charges recommended to the District Attorney for Burglary, Obstructing, Possession of Heroin, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Theft.
